Paul Wayne Allen, 61, went home to be with the Lord on Sunday, January 16, 2022. Born February 10, 1960 to Robert and Joan Allen, Paul was raised in Helotes, TX and grew up with a love of the outdoors. As a young man, he was an active member of the Alamo Area Council Boy Scouts, Troop 401, and achieved the distinguished rank of Eagle Scout in 1975.

Following graduation from John Marshall High School in 1978, Paul went on to obtain his Bachelor's degree in Construction Science from Texas A&M University where he was the proudest member of the Fighting Texas Aggie Class of 1987. For his entire life, Paul embodied the Aggie Spirit, with a loyalty and love for his alma mater that was unparalleled.
