Richard Lemley died peacefully on November 3, 2017, in Richmond, Texas, at the age of 81. He was born on February 22, 1936, in Huntsville, Texas. Richard graduated from Roy Miller High School in Corpus Christi, served honorably in the United States Marine Corps and earned his Engineering degree from Texas College of Arts & Industries in Kingsville becoming a Registered Professional Engineer specializing in Structural Engineering. After working with a post-tensioning company, he started his own post-tensioning manufacturing company and continued as a consulting engineer before retiring in 2008. Ever the entrepreneur, he also developed a partnership to design and build houses in Dallas.

Richard is survived by his wife Patricia Rioux Lemley, his brother George Lemley and wife Martha, his niece Laura Jean Stroud and husband James, nephew Douglas Lemley, his sister-in-law Virgie Rioux Johnson and husband James, brother-in-law Bill Rioux and wife Janie, brother-in-law Tom Rioux and wife Anne, and numerous other relatives. He was preceded in death by his parents Richard and Laura Lee Lemley and nephew John Lemley.

He was an avid sports fan and conversations with him were always enlightening. His Dallas Cowboys gave him more joys than sorrows. The recent Astros World Series championship was a real high. If he wasn't watching golf tournaments on television, he was on the Pecan Grove course.

His collection of caps attests to his years of participation in the Senior Men's Golf Association, not to mention trophies and awards. They won fishing tournaments, too.

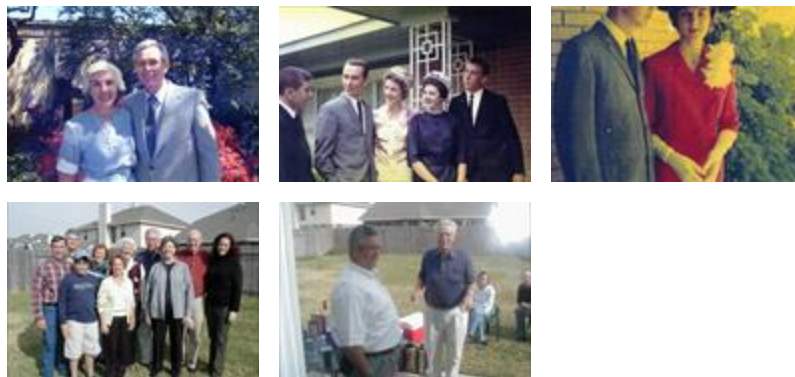
