Robert Anthony Ochoa, Sr. (73) passed away on August 31st, 2023, with his loving family by his side. Born September 16th, 1949 to Matias and Frances Ochoa in Ganado, Texas, Robert lived a rambunctious young life in Louise, Texas with his parents, siblings, and other family nearby.

After graduating from Louise High School in 1968, Robert attended the University of Houston obtaining a Bachelor of Science in Education in 1975. He had countless memories of eating at Moody Towers with the Brezina boys and loved his time on campus.

He started his career as a Computer Programmer for Mobil Oil, then found his way to a position in Commercial Construction with Austin Bridge.
