Sherry R. Stogner, 85 of Louise, passed away on July 21, 2016. She was born on September 12, 1930 in Morgan City, Louisiana to the late John and Olive Ells Robisheaux. She was a longtime teacher in the Louise ISD and retired from teaching in 1989 and then served on the School Board for several years.
