Sidonia Vera Hradecky, 88, of El Campo, passed away October 24, 2016. Sidonia was born November 17, 1927 in Gonzalez, TX to the late Edward Jaks and Mary Glomb Jaks. She successfully managed to have a career and raise a family long before it was considered the norm. After attending secretarial college in San Antonio, Sidonia began working as book keeper for Mack J. Webb Hardware. She then became a tax consultant for Cy Hoover, CPA. After a short break, she resumed work as secretary to the engineering department of the El Campo Texaco office, and finally became a legal secretary at Duckett, Bouligny and Collins where she retired after over 20 years.

When Sidonia was twenty, she married the love of her life, Aldrich Hradecky, and together they raised a loving family, remaining in El Campo together surrounded by all their wonderful friends.
