Teresa Rose "Terrie" Kennedy (née Bronkema), age 67, passed away on December 7, 2025, in Round Rock, Texas. Born on March 5, 1958, in Norfolk, Virginia, Terrie lived a life marked by compassion, resilience, and unwavering dedication to others.

Terrie pursued her education at Jacksonville State College and went on to build a distinguished career as a registered nurse that spanned over four decades. Her early years were spent working in neonatal care at Texas Children's Hospital, where she played a pivotal role in launching the Kangaroo Flight Club—an initiative that brought comfort and connection to families during critical times. Later in her career, she served as Lead Nurse at West Oaks Psychiatric and Rehabilitation Center, where her leadership and empathy left a lasting impact on both patients and colleagues.

Beyond her professional accomplishments, Terrie was deeply committed to helping others through their personal journeys. She was in recovery for over 30 years and became a guiding light for many women navigating their own paths to healing. Her sponsorship and mentorship were rooted in genuine care and an unshakable belief in the power of transformation.

Terrie's spirituality was central to her life. She had a profound love for God and carried her faith with grace and humility. Those who knew her often spoke of

her uncanny ability to maintain a positive attitude even in the face of adversity. She had an extraordinary gift for being fully present—offering comfort, strength, or simply a listening ear whenever it was needed most.

She is lovingly remembered by her husband John; her three sons Kade, Skip, and Sean; her mother Joan; her grandchildren Grace, Logan and Carter; her siblings John, Tony, Ray, Robbie and Donna as well as countless others whose lives she touched with kindness and strength. She was preceded in death by her father, John Bronkema. Terrie was an amazing mother and devoted wife.

Celebration of Terrie's life will be February 7, 2026 at St. Andrew Catholic Church in Hillje. Visitation with the family will begin at 9 am with a Rosary being recited at 9:30 am.
