Verna Janet House Entricht, 90, of El Campo, passed away on November 29, 2024. She was born in El Campo on August 13, 1934, to J.V. and Letha Chandler House.

After graduating from El Campo High School in 1952, she attended WCJC and then received B.A. and M. Ed degrees from the University of Houston. She taught in the Crescent and El Campo school districts for thirty-eight years before retiring in 1994.

Janet married Lewis Entricht, Sr., on Christmas Day in 1955, and their love continued for 36 years until his death in 1992. They enjoyed many outdoor activities together, such as camping, hunting, and fishing.

Janet was a member of the First Baptist Church for over 75 years.

In addition to her husband and parents, Janet was predeceased by her brothers, Jerry House and wife Mary, Larry House and wife Margaret, and her best friend and loving companion of 17 years, Bob Hessong.
