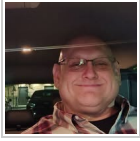

In lieu of flowers, Dad was a big supporter of St. Jude's Children's Hospital and the Wounded Warrior Project.

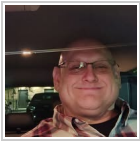
