



Wayne Dennis Zaskoda

August 19, 1950 - December 23, 2018

Wayne Dennis Zaskoda, 68, was born August 19, 1950, to Dennis and Evelyn Parma Zaskoda. Many of his long-time friends knew him as Squeaky, a nickname received during his Little League baseball days.

Anyone who knew Wayne knew of his love for sports and of his all-around athletic ability. He was on the Senior Little League team that advanced to the World Series finals in 1965. Baseball was not his only talent; he received 10 letters in high school sports. His senior year, he was quarterback on the 1968 state finalist football team and helped the El Campo Ricebirds win the 1968 State Championship title in baseball that same year. Wayne planned to attend Texas A&M on a football scholarship, but when offered a professional baseball contract with the Baltimore Orioles, he chose baseball.

After three years with the Orioles, Wayne completed his degree and returned to El Campo to coach. Then, fulfilling any sports fan's dream, became part owner of the Sports Center, following in his father-in-law's footsteps. After the Sports Center closed, he worked at Mark's Machine Co. in sales and, finally, LL&F Construction as a field superintendent until his cancer diagnosis. Wayne fought a long, courageous battle against the disease, always remaining hopeful and positive.

Wayne passed away surrounded by his loving family on December 23, 2018.

He will be deeply missed, but we take comfort in knowing that he is free of pain and surrounded by loved ones who went before him.

He is survived by his wife of 44 years, Mary Beth Morgan Zaskoda; sons, Scott Zaskoda of Austin and Jeffrey Zaskoda of Dallas; brother, Gary Zaskoda and wife Yvonne of Nevada and many other loved family members and friends.

A memorial service will be held at 2:00 pm on December 27, 2018 at St. Philip Catholic Church.
