William "Bill" Wayne Brandl, 75, of Houston, passed away December 8, 2015. He was born on March 17, 1940 in El Campo, Tx to the late Willie and Evelyn Sohrt Brandl.

Billy grew up and attended school in the Louise/El Campo area, where he graduated as Valedictorian of Louise High School in 1958 and served as FFA President and class Vice-President. He graduated with honors from Wharton County Junior College in 1960 and Sam Houston State University in 1962. He served as President of Aggie/Rodeo Club at WCJC and was a member of Pioneer Band. He received a Master of Education degree from Southwest Texas State Teacher's College in 1965. Bill taught school for 28 years including at Victoria ISD, Texas City ISD, Deer Park ISD, Dayton ISD and Houston ISD. He served on the coaching staff and was team leader while at Deer Park ISD.

Bill married Viola Geesing Brandl in 1969, who preceded him in death in 1999 after 30 years of marriage. Both Bill and Viola had numerous hobbies, including travel, camping, fishing, hiking, music and gardening.

After his retirement from teaching, Bill served as a substitute teacher at Pearland and Clear Creek ISD. He worked security in summers and holidays and worked in retirement for The Wackenhut Corp., Industrial Security Corp.

and other guard services.

Both Bill and Viola were members of St. Francis Cabrini, Guardian Angel and St. Albert's Catholic Churches. He was a member of St. Albert's Church of Houston and the Senior Club there until his death.

He is survived by numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.

Bill was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Viola Geesing Brandl; brothers, Norman and Melvin Brandl, and numerous aunts, uncles, grandparents and cousins.

Graveside services will be held at 4 p.m. on Wednesday, December 16, 2015 at St. Andrew's Cemetery in Hillje with Rev. Clement Quainoo officiating.
